General Information

Saint Joseph Regional Medical Center is sponsored by Trinity Health, the fourth largest Catholic healthcare system in the U.S. Located in North Central Indiana, SJRMC provides faith-based care to the entire Michiana region. Today, Saint Joseph Regional Medical Center offers world-class technology and the most advanced procedures as well as a dedicated and caring staff.

Hospital System

South Bend Acute Care Facility: This 303-bed facility is located in downtown South Bend. It provides a full range of healthcare services, including cardiac, oncology, orthopedics, obstetrics, emergency medicine, surgery, pediatrics, a certified stroke unit and general inpatient care. In December 2009, this campus will transition to a new hospital currently being constructed less than 5 miles away in the neighboring city of Mishawaka.

Plymouth Acute Care Facility: This 58-bed facility is located just outside of downtown Plymouth. Services including obstetrics, emergency medicine, inpatient/outpatient surgery, oncology, MRI, wound healing and intensive care.

Mishawaka Campus: This facility provides a variety of outpatient services in downtown Mishawaka, including a freestanding Emergency Department, Wound Healing Center, laboratory and radiology.

Elm Road Medical Campus: Located on the south side of Mishawaka, this new facility, along with South Bend Orthopaedics and the South Bend Medical Foundation, provides a hub of medical services. Our facility houses a family medicine practice, a Sleep Lab, rehabilitation, occupational health and infusion. In addition, SJRMC is constructing the Michiana Rehabilitation Institute, a 40-bed inpatient rehabilitation facility, at this location.

Edison Lakes Medical Center: Located in Mishawaka, this facility provides a variety of specialty services including an Eye Surgical Center, Sports Medicine Institute and orthopedic and industrial rehabilitation.

Saint Joseph Physician Network: More than 50 physicians specializing in family practice, internal medicine, obstetrics, urgent care and more make up the Saint Joseph Physician Network, the largest hospital-based physician group in our area.

Urgent Care Center: Conveniently open from 8 a.m. – 8 p.m., 365 days a year to provide care for those with minor illnesses and injuries. No appointment is necessary, and physicians are on site, along with lab and X-ray services.

Clinical Expertise

Cardiovascular Program: SJRMC's Cardiovascular Program unites cardiologists, radiologists, cardiac surgeons and vascular surgeons to achieve a higher quality of care. Physicians work closely together, providing clear direction on the best approaches for quality and safety. The program is the only one in the area giving physicians a direct voice in day-to-day management standards.

Orthopedics Program: SJRMC's Orthopedics Program works to return patients to normal function as quickly and safely as possible. Medical professionals employ a comprehensive, leading edge approach to the prevention, assessment, treatment and rehabilitation of musculoskeletal injuries. Staff work with each patient and his or her primary care physician to develop a treatment plan specifically for that patient.

Cancer Program: The Saint Joseph Cancer Institute specializes in the diagnosis and treatment of all forms of cancer. Both the South Bend and Plymouth locations offer a complete continuum of care, from preventative education and early detection through recovery and support. Using a multidisciplinary team approach, staff works to provide excellent care and management of the cancer, its treatments and side effects, to allow the patient the highest quality of life.

Image Recovery Center: The Image Recovery Center helps patients understand and prepare for appearance changes that may occur during chemotherapy, radiation therapy or surgery. The Center provides education and aesthetic tools to help enhance patients' lives and appearances both during and after treatment. The Center offers massages, facials, wig fitting, haircuts, manicures and breast fittings. It also carries items specifically designed for cancer patients including special skin care products, hats, turbans, swimsuits, camisoles, breast prostheses and bras.

Wound Healing Center: The Wound Healing Center, with locations in Mishawaka, South Bend and Plymouth, is staffed by a team of skilled professionals, including doctors, nurses and respiratory therapists, who specialize in advanced treatment methods of non-healing wounds. Our physician-driven program is the only one within a 75-mile radius that includes the use of hyperbaric chamber and hyperbaric oxygen therapy.

Eye Surgical Center: Established to fill a need within the community, the Eye Surgical Center handles over 200 cases each month. The separate suite located on the Edison Lakes campus was designed for the unique flow of patients having eye surgery. This allows for patients to have their pre-operation, procedure, and recovery all in the same area.

Pediatric Specialty Clinics: In affiliation with the Riley Hospital for Children, our clinics serve as a referral center for children whose conditions require specialized evaluation and treatment. The Clinics make it possible for young patients and their families to receive care locally from area specialists as well as visiting physicians from Riley Hospital for Children in Indianapolis.

New Hospital Facility

SJRMC’s new \$355 million world-class hospital is on schedule to open December 14, 2009. Located near the intersection of Main and Douglas streets in Mishawaka, the facility features 254 large private inpatient rooms to accommodate patients and visitors.

The core of the new campus will be a large, two-story diagnostic and treatment center. Medical office buildings will connect to the hospital to provide convenient access for patients and physicians. Designed with a focus on efficiency and patient safety, the hospital will offer the latest medical technology and a full range of healthcare services.

Hospital System

Plymouth Acute Care Facility: This 58-bed facility is located just outside of downtown Plymouth. Services include obstetrics, emergency medicine, inpatient/outpatient surgery, radiation oncology, oncology services, MRI, intensive care and general inpatient care.

South Bend Acute Care Facility: This 303-bed facility is located in downtown South Bend. Services include cardiac, oncology, orthopedics, obstetrics, emergency medicine, surgery, pediatrics and general inpatient care.

Mishawaka Acute Care Facility: This 125-bed facility is located in downtown Mishawaka. Services include cardiac, obstetrics, emergency medicine, surgery, wound healing and general inpatient care.

Our Lady of Peace Hospital: This 24-bed hospital is located on the fourth floor of the South Bend facility. It delivers care to acutely ill adult patients who require a longer than usual length of stay. This includes post-operative patients requiring frequent and/or complex dressing changes, patients suffering from lung disorders or patients not yet ready for intensive rehabilitation.

Edison Lakes Medical Center: This facility offers outpatient surgical services, radiology services, and lab results. Physician offices are also scattered throughout the facility and provide services including internal medicine, urology, sports medicine, physical therapy and rehabilitation.

Saint Joseph Visiting Nurses Association Home Care

Provides healthcare and therapy services in homes across a six-county service area. Offer specialized comprehensive services, including nursing, physical therapy, speech therapy, occupational therapy, pharmacy and infusion services. The only homecare agency with Wound Care Certified specialists who service St. Joseph, Marshall and Elkhart counties.

Breastfeeding Center

SJRCM's Breastfeeding Center employees include one board certified lactation consultant and two other lactation consultants that educate families about the process. Women can also join a breastfeeding support group, and take advantage of support groups for both English and Spanish-speaking patients. At the Center, women can purchase or rent breast pumps and other supplies.

The Clinics serve as a referral center for children whose conditions require special evaluation and treatment. These clinics make it possible for our young patients to receive the care they need locally.

Due to a strong relationship with South Bend Orthopaedics, surgeons from SBO perform elective orthopedic procedures at the Plymouth Campus. This enables patients to have surgery in Plymouth's state-of-the-art suites, conveniently close to home. Our surgeons will also be onsite to follow the care of our patients.
